THE MILLION MEAL MIRACLE

GOALS & OBJECTIVES

The ultimate goal of the project is to nourish and empower school children in Zimbabwe and Somaliland. We want to address immediate nutritional needs and instil a sense of significance and value in these young lives - fostering a brighter future for them and the communities they belong to.

Over the next two years, Feed The Hungry's mission will be to:

- Engage 200 UK Schools in assembling and packaging at least 5,000 meals per school - totalling 1,000,000 meals.
- These carefully prepared and scientifically proven nutritious meals will be dispatched to our trusted partners in Zimbabwe and Somaliland, where they will be distributed to provide essential warm meals to children in schools and orphanages.
- Our programme in the UK will implement structured lesson plans to educate the students about the critical global hunger challenges, faced by those their age, in less privileged nations.

In addition, The Million Meal Miracle will help to connect local communities in the UK, creating partnerships between supporting businesses, churches and community groups, and their local schools.

Patience lives with her Grandmother, auntie, sister and cousins in Epworth, a suburb of Harare, Zimbabwe. Her family struggle to find work and doesn’t have much money.

Every day, Patience has to go to her neighbours and beg for food. Sometimes, they give her their leftover food but, at other times, the family go to bed having not eaten.

Feed The Hungry visited Patience’s school and wanted to help. Within days, a feeding programme was started and now, Patience and her sister and cousins, along with 250 other young people at The Open Tribe school, get a regular meal.

For Patience and her family, this is world-changing.

HOW IT WORKS

The Million Meal Miracle encompasses two key aspects - lessons and food packing. These elements work together to provide a comprehensive and impactful educational experience for Key Stage 2 and 3 students.

LESSONS

Initially, the project involves a series of lessons fostering an understanding of justice and responsibility among students. In a single-year group of four classes, they will undertake a one-and-a-half to two-hour lesson delivered by up to two members of our trained Schools Team.

In this exciting lesson, students embark on a captivating journey of global awareness through engaging activities.



FOOD PACKING EVENT

The Food Packing event is a fun activity and a meaningful way to engage with practical social justice worldwide.

During this event, students participate in a simple and hands-on process, creating bagged meals that will be sent to some of the world's neediest children via our trusted partners in schools and orphanages in Zimbabwe and Somaliland.

They will mix and pack ingredients like dried rice, soya, lentils and essential micronutrients.

Each bag contains six meals, feeding six children. We provide all the equipment needed, including the equipment for measuring and sealing, ensuring the food stays fresh and clean during shipping.

As the teachers and students work together, we'll celebrate each milestone with the sounding of a gong.

The meals the students pack will go directly from their hands to those of the hungry children who need them most, making this a practical way to make a real difference in some of the world's most disadvantaged areas while having an enjoyable time doing it.

Feed The Hungry oversees the whole process to ensure that the food gets to where it is intended. We work with trusted partners in each of the countries in which we operate, with traceability at each stage of the journey.

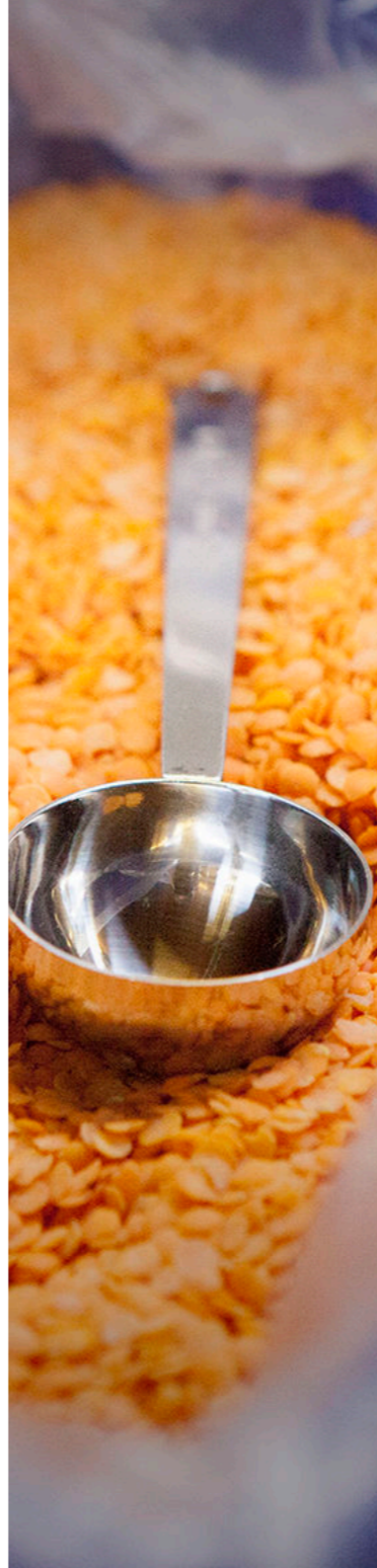
OUTCOMES & IMPACTS

FOR SCHOOLS IN THE UK

- UK pupils will grasp global hunger challenges and become lifelong advocates for change; championing equality and hunger alleviation worldwide.
- Cross-cultural exchanges will nurture empathy and global solidarity, fostering deep understanding of diverse cultures and perspectives.
- Dialogue about different cultures will encourage value examination, fostering respect for differences and combating prejudice, contributing to a more inclusive society.

FOR SCHOOLS IN AFRICA

- Nutritious meals will improve overall health, reducing child malnutrition and supporting their physical and cognitive development, in turn enhancing their learning and prospects.
- Addressing hunger boosts academic focus, cognitive function and concentration, breaking the cycle of poverty by promoting better educational outcomes for young people.
- Breaking the hunger cycle leads to pupils becoming healthier adults, reducing healthcare burdens and enhancing economic productivity in their countries.



THE MILLION MEAL MIRACLE

COST OF THE PROJECT

Feed The Hungry intentionally keeps the cost of running events as low as possible in order to make them affordable. By comparison, similar organisations running food packing events have much higher costs associated with these events.

The cost of running a 5,000 meal packing event is £2,080. This includes the cost of ingredients and all event costs associated with one school running the event.

The Million Meal Miracle is only possible with the financial support of partners, sowing into the lives of school pupils in the UK and young people living in challenging circumstances around the world.
